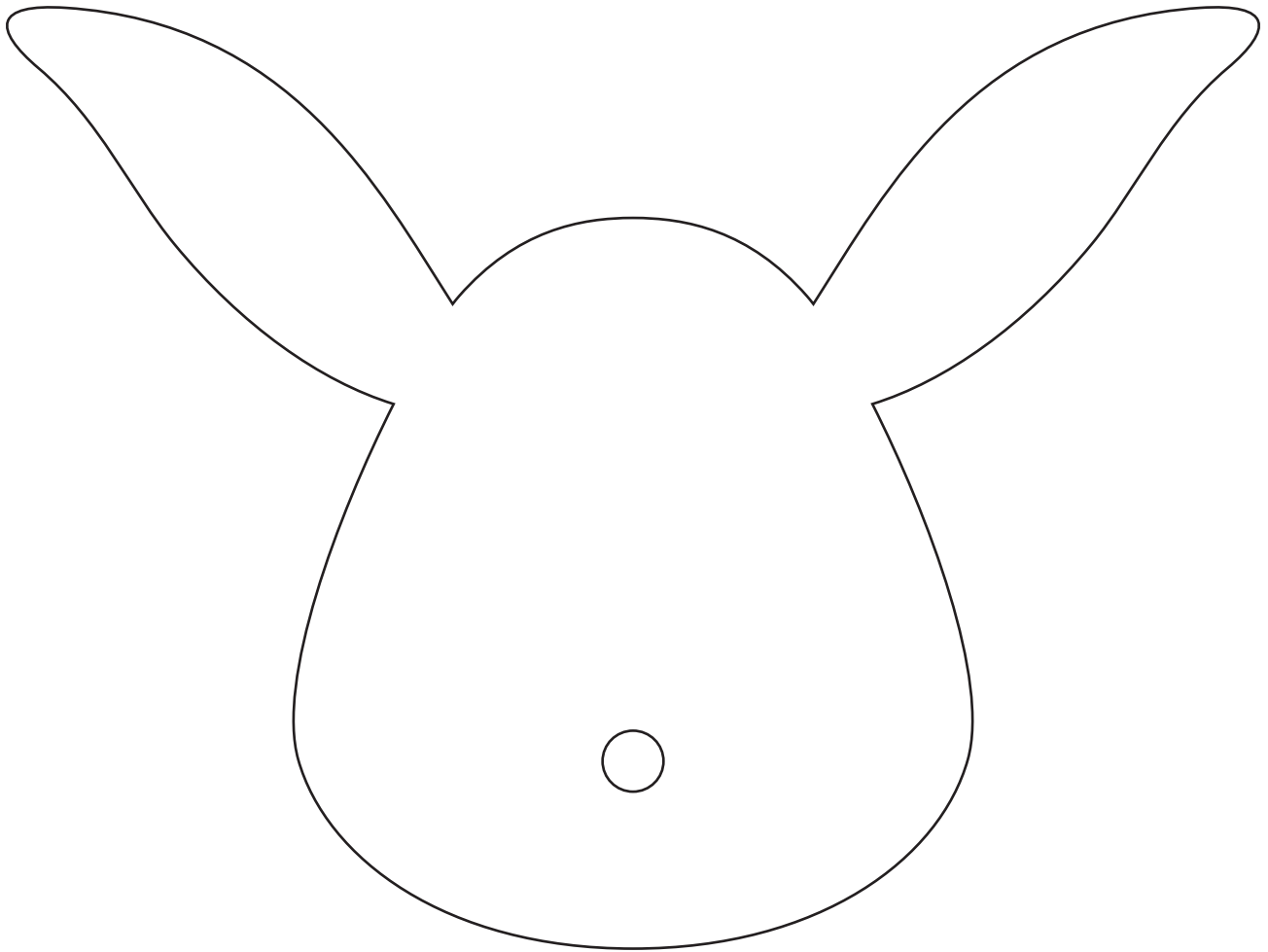

- decorating materials if desired

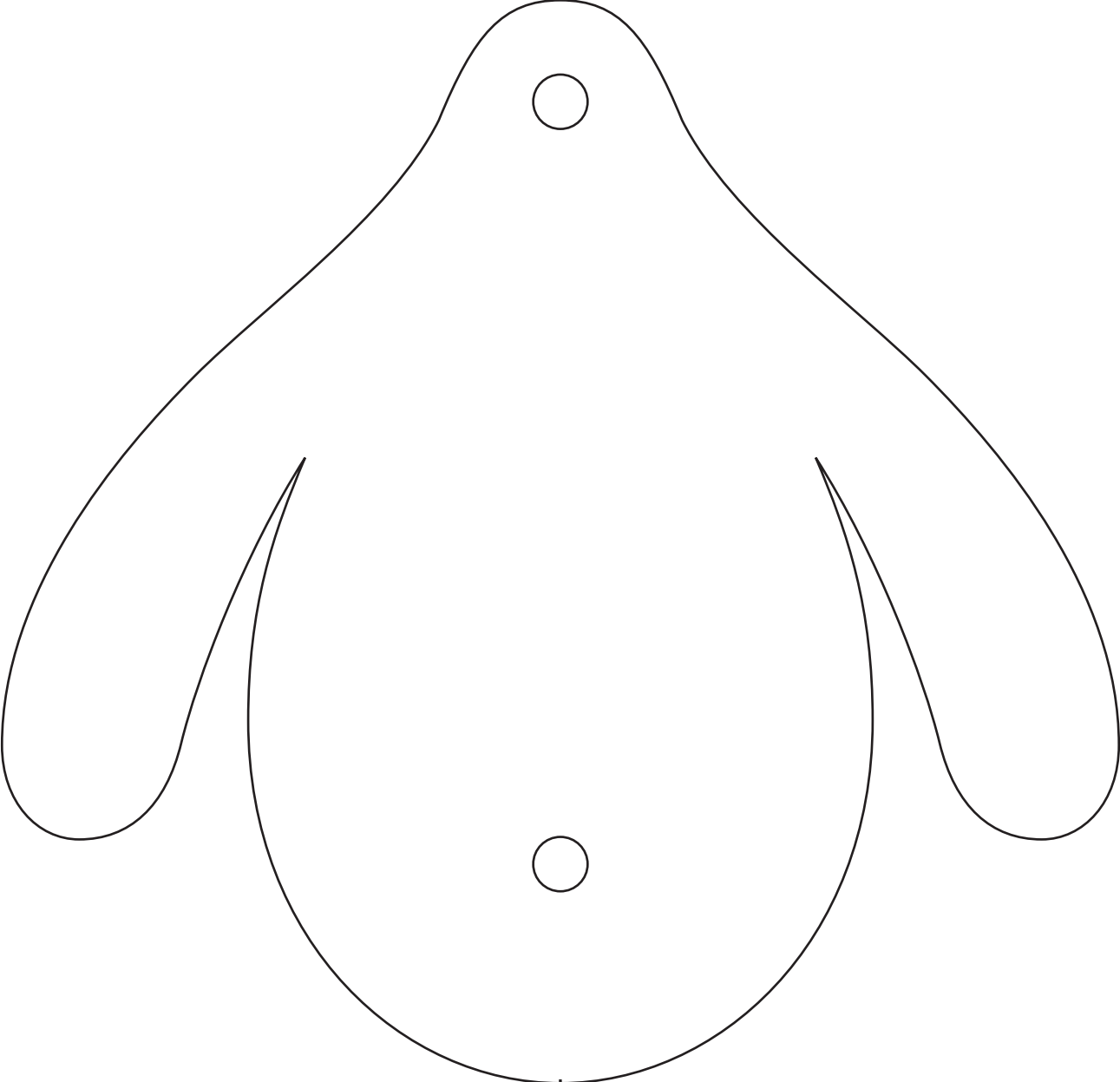

**Body**

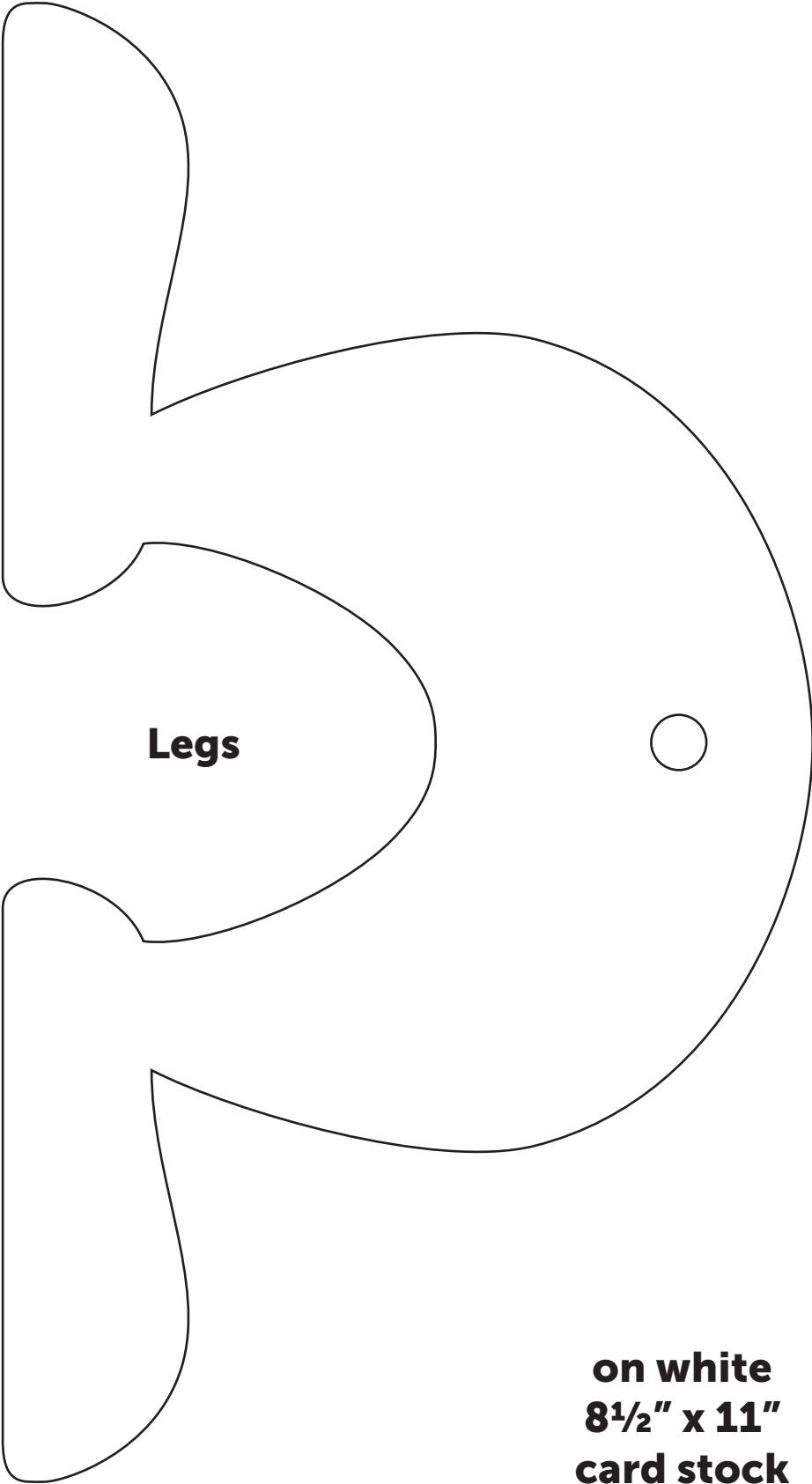

# Substitution List for Materials/Supplies

**(or be creative and go on a treasure hunt to find your own!)**

**Card stock:** Other options could be cereal boxes, tissue boxes, or other light cardboard.

**Chenille stems:** Other options could be a twist tie from a loaf of bread, a portion of a zip tie, a bit of old wire or a piece of guitar/shamisen/ukulele string.

**Chopsticks:** Other options could be unsharpened pencils, ink pens that are dried up, or sticks from the yard or park.

**Craft sticks:** Other options could be used Popsicle® sticks, plastic knives, scraps of wood or even a piece of corrugated cardboard (with the corrugation going the long/vertical way).

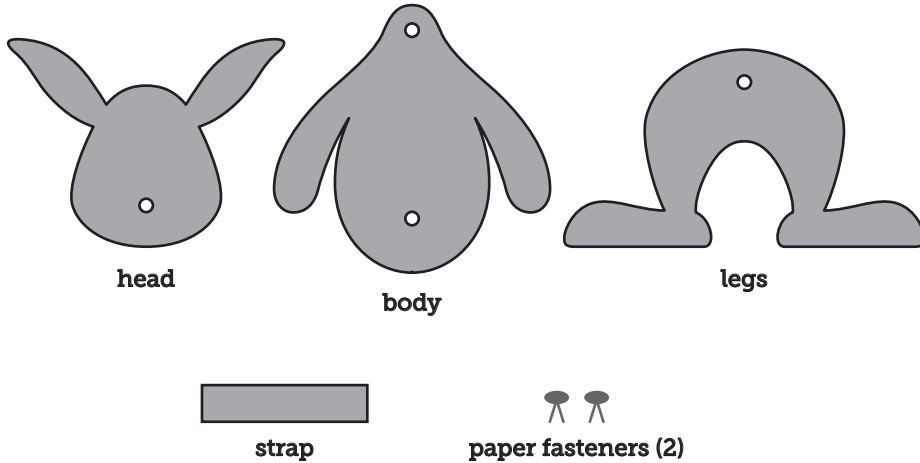
**Paper fasteners:** Another option could be a 2" piece of string (see "string" below for more ideas). Insert string into the hole of the top piece, leaving about a 1" portion showing. Tape down this piece with a piece of masking or other kind of tape. Insert the other end of string (which is coming from under the other side) and insert it into the other (bottom) piece's hole. Pull it through firmly and tape down string to bottom of bottom piece.

**String:** Other options could be strong thread, fishing line, kite string, dental floss or light gauge wire (such as floral wire).

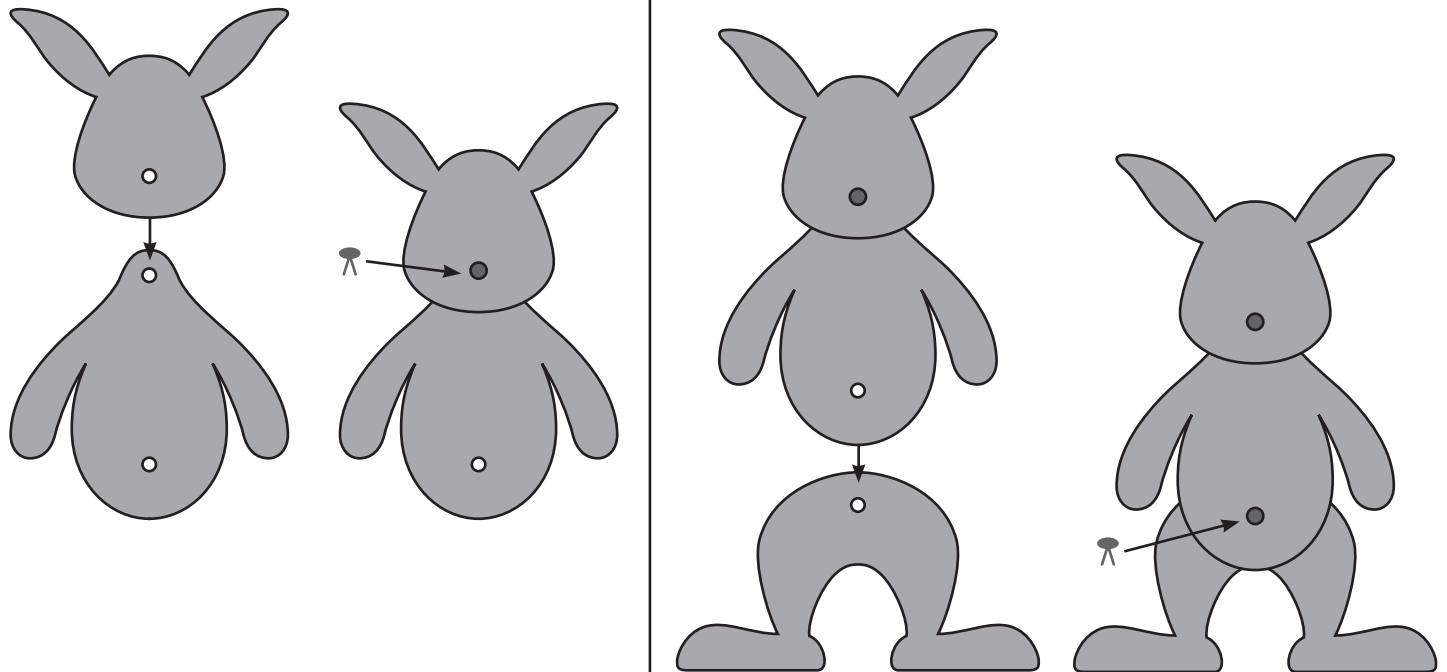

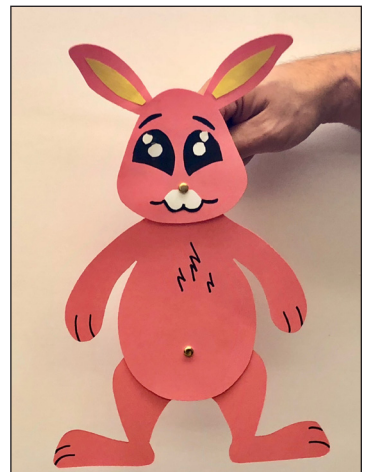
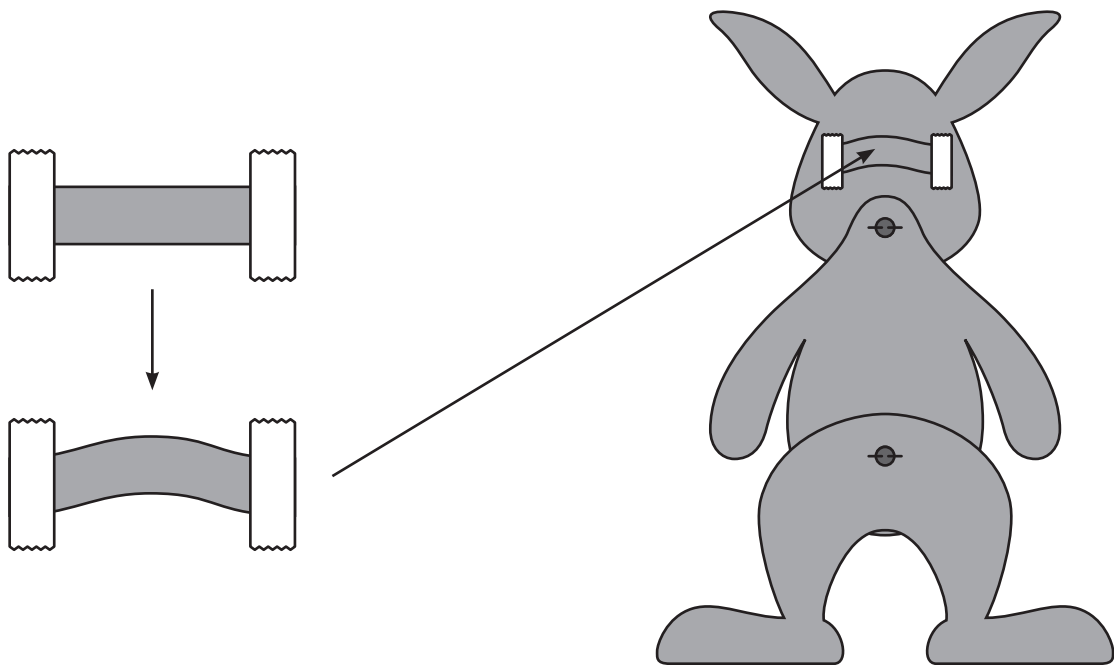
