Abstract: Contains a collection of materials pertaining to Jim Henson, Jim Henson Company television and film productions, and the Muppets.

Administrative Information

Provenance: This collection contains materials donated by the Jim Henson Company and the Jim Henson Legacy, as well as materials collected by the Center for Puppetry Arts.

Processing History: This collection contains materials from Karen Falk, Jim Henson Company's Archive Director, the Jim Henson Legacy, and various donors to the Center for Puppetry Arts. Processing of the collection started in May of 2022 by creating a finding aid for this collection. A Fonds record was created in 2023, with cataloging done at the container level.

No documentation exists for when this collection was first created. It is a collection of materials from multiple sources gathered into a collection based on topic. Sources include Jim Henson Company, the Jim Henson Legacy, and independent donations of materials found in the archive, which were donated without documentation over time prior to 2023. The collection may continue to grow as new materials are acquired which fit into the scope of this collection and which do not warrant an independent accession.

Copyright Status: Some material may be copyrighted or restricted. It is the patron's obligation to determine and satisfy copyright or other case restrictions when publishing or otherwise distributing materials found in the collections.

Access and Restrictions: The Nancy Staub Puppetry Research Library is open to researchers by appointment only. The library is available Tuesday – Friday from 10:00 to 4:00. It is suggested that researchers set up an appointment at least 2 weeks in advance.

Scope and Content Note: The Jim Henson Collection contains information, style guides, publications, photographs, films, and ephemera pertaining to Jim Henson, Jim Henson Company television and film productions, and the Muppets. Much of the collection is ephemera related to various Henson productions, the Muppets, and exhibitions related to Jim Henson and his works. The publications include books about television and film productions like *The Dark Crystal*, *Fraggle Rock*, and *Labyrinth* as well as comics about *The Dark Crystal*. Films include the series *Here Come the Puppets!* and *Jim Henson's World of Puppetry*. Also included is reference information for some puppets in the Center for Puppetry Arts' permanent museum collection, including Cosmo from *Star Boppers* and the Storyteller Dog from *Storyteller*.
