Provenance: This collection contains materials donated to the Center for Puppetry Arts by Bonnie Erickson from her career with the Jim Henson Company and her company (Harrison/Erickson) with husband and business partner Wayde Harrison.

Processing History: This collection contains materials sent to CPA by Bonnie Erickson. Paulette Richards initially began processing the collection in 2016. About six years passed with changes to the department and the COVID-19 pandemic, the processing of the collection stopped. In 2022, Collections Manager, Yanique Hall, completed the processing of the collection by using preservation methods and rehousing the materials in archival boxes. In 2023, Collections Manager Micah Walsh created catalog records for this collection in the database.

Biographical/Historical Information

Bonnie Erickson grew up in Saint Paul, Minnesota. She moved to New York City in the 1960s and studied sculpture at the Art Students' League. While working for designer, Patricia Quinn Stuart, she created costumes and props for Broadway and off-Broadway shows. Jim Henson hired her in 1970 to create the costumes for "The Frog Prince," a television pilot. Erickson enjoyed working as a free-lance designer but Henson recruited her to join The Muppets and she became the head of the Muppets Workshop. In this capacity, she set up the workshop in London that built puppets for *The Muppet Show* and designed several iconic characters including Miss Piggy, Zoot, and Statler and Waldorf.

Erickson left The Muppets in1977 to start her own company but Henson remained an important client, hiring her to oversee the build for *Fraggle Rock* and referring her to clients like the Phillies MLB team. Starting in 1978 Erickson, with her husband Wade Harrison, secured contracts to design and manage licensing for 16 major league sports mascots. The Philly Phanatic remains the most popular. Erickson also worked as the Creative Director of the Product Division of Children's Television Workshop for 13 years.

Erickson worked with the Smithsonian to develop the traveling exhibit "Jim Henson's Fantastic World" which toured from 2007 – 2013. She became Executive Director of the Jim Henson Legacy in 2011.

Scope and Content Note

Materials in the collection include photographs dating from 1968 through 2016 with many production stills from *Sesame Street, Saturday Night Live, The Muppet Show, Fraggle Rock,* and *The Bunny Picnic;* greeting cards exchanged within the Children's Television Workshop and the Henson Company; newspaper and magazine clippings; oversized promotional materials from Harrison/Erickson creations and style guides for licensed Muppet characters. Additionally, there are puppet patterns from the Harrison/Erickson Company of characters in the Center for Puppetry Arts' permanent museum collection.

Organization of the Papers (Series): The collection is arranged in seven series. The first series is organized into three boxes where the information focuses on *Sesame Street*. The second, third, fourth and seventh series are organized in boxes; the individual folders in each box are organized chronologically. The fifth and sixth series follow the original organization put in place by the creator; the organization appears to be alphabetical by the full title. The series are:
